	Give the account a Title EG. webconnex or Work Username: (provided by admin) Password: (provided by admin) Next, tap Advanced Settings

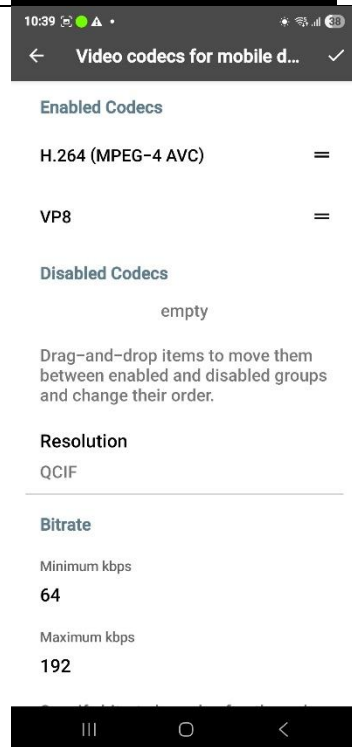

	Tap DTMF Mode This is used for responding to auto attendant menus (Dial 1 for this, dial 2 for that, etc.) You can drag them around with the handle that looks like = Tap the back icon when done (Top left)

	Tap Secure Calls Note: External calls are always insecure. You can enable these for incoming and outgoing Tap the back icon when done (Top left)
	Under Notifications, set expires to at least 600 Tap the checkmark icon to save the setting when done (Top right) Tap the back icon a couple of times to get back to the dial pad.
